Rajkiya Mahila Snatakottar Mahavidyalaya fosters to pursue international quality standards of excellence in Academics, Research and Consultancy, Administration, Extension Services. Some of the distinctive practices pursued by the institute are as follows:

**Cross Functional Learning:** Despite being away from the mega centres of power and influence, In learning process, every student of the college is put through a judicious blend of concepts and practices associated with good infrastructure facilities in a dynamic environment. The students are taught through a transformative development experience, intellectual growth, with practical knowledge with sound judgment. Teaching / Assignments / presentation / GDs etc. for teaching learning. As the most departments lack in faculty strength, so there is regular planning for Extension Lecture / Guest Lecture in the college.

**Sukirti, Kirti, Lakshya, and Bhiti Patrika:** College publishes annual magazines regularly, for that articles from students, teachers and alumni are invited after editing by editorial team they get published. Lakshya is a half yearly magazine published in form of news bulletin to cover the event and expression of students. BhitiPatrika is a unique space for students to express creativity. Sukirti is an eresearch journal under publication to provide opportunity to the research scholars and faculty members to share their research findings.

Case Analysis / Applied Problems Solving: To develop the conceptual skills, to identify & formulate and solve problems innovatively, students undertake Case Studies and Simulation Exercises. Cases are generously selected in the contextual setting and information adequacy which characterizes the fulfilment of course design. The case includes the study of pregnant ladies in District Women Hospital, Blind School, Primary Schools of the nearby locality, Opium factory in the city, Sukhbir Agro business industry in proximity etc. These case analyses develop decision making skills under simulated conditions and highlight the fact that the real situations are more complex than what the students learn in theory in the class room. In due course of learning; Debate / Role Play / Professional Development Plans / Aptitude & Technology Skill Development / Soft Skills Development / Concept Classes / Workshops etc. are also structured to enhance the outcomes.

**Remedial and Tutorials:** Students are categorised on the basis of overall performance in the college activities. The remedial classes are planned for slow learners while the star performers have an opportunity to excel in the concern subject through tutorials. In Remedial and tutorial classes, students undertake



group discussion, problems faced in lectures room, quiz, class test, work exercise, in supervision of a faculty. These measures improve the knowledge in the subject and appropriate planning of any work for achieving the objective.

Student Mentoring: The college offers students services like Counselling, Guidance, Training support, Personality grooming and Field excursion / Motivational Lectures / Winter Training for short term skill development / Seminar / Project Report / Continuous Evaluation of the students. Beside counselling cell there is Kunj system followed in the college for healthy and collaborative learning. **Publication:** The College undertakes to publish all the Research Articles presented in the conferences in the form of Book Proceeding. The college every year conducts 1-2 National Seminars/ Workshop funded by UGC, ICSSR, IPR, State Government of U.P. and other research promoting agencies/institutions in collaboration of several organisations. Further, student Information Bulletin familiarizes for various activities like rules & regulations of the institute, academic calendar, ragging, alumni club, sports, youth festivals, annual day celebration. Institute is committed to students and corporate partners and use technology in education as passion.

Consultancy: The College feels proud in sharing the responsibility of state machinery by providing consultancy services to various government and non-government organisations. Principal and many faculty members are called by district administration and University for consultancy services in education, planning, environment conservation, swachhata abhiyan, girls' education, implementation of several schemes and cultural promotion. Several selection



committees of government have board members from this institute. Not only government agencies but the NGOs and civil society also take regular consult for betterment of the community.

School Outreach Programmes: The school teachers shape their students, who go for higher education, it is important to reach them so that they came aware of the latest trend and transformations of higher education. To create awareness and to bridge the gap on these aspects, we have designed a few outreach programmes for students and teachers of school. Faculty members from the college make visits to the Kendriya Vidyalaya, Navodaya Vidyalaya, Government Girls Inter College, Ludre's Convent School, MAH Inter College, Azimia Inter College to get engaged with them.

**Maang kar Padhenge:** This campaign was started by Professor Savita Bhardwaj, Principal of the college, in 2019. Its purpose is to expand the academic culture in the college and to keep the local community continuously participating and active for the development of the college.

In this scheme, library facilities are being expanded by getting help from visitors, educationists, parents, teachers and alumni coming to the college. The greatest feature of this scheme is to go beyond any set limit of purchase rules and get donations of books, for which one does not have to depend on government grants-in-aid. So far, more than 300 books have been collected by various donors through this scheme, whose value is more than 50,000. In addition to local history, culture and folk arts, a collection of useful compositions for competitive examinations, special books and courses is included in these books. Teachers of the college have donated their research work and self written books under this scheme.



Hamare Bhamashah: "हमारे भामाशाह" was started in the academic session of 2021-21 by the college in order motivate the generous hearts to help our students with rewards to boost up their performance of excellence.

The idea was to facilitate students with financial help in the form of award and honour as well as to motivate students to excel in their performance. As the students come from poor financial background it could prove as a catalyst to the financially challenged parents to permit their children for the pursuance of higher education. Moreover, the idea also could open the opportunity to the generous hands to feel the pleasure of helping the needy and the scholarly students.
